| <p>Executive Summary</p> <p>World Antibiotic Awareness Week and European Antibiotic Awareness Day occur in November each year and are an important part of the international programme to raise awareness amongst prescribers and the public of the scale and importance of the issue of antimicrobial resistance (AMR). To coincide with this campaign, the attached paper describes the current position with regard to antibiotic prescribing in our North Yorkshire CCGs. The actions undertaken by the Medicines Management Team (MMT) to promote this initiative, in conjunction with the communications team, are also described.</p> <p>Decreases in total antibiotic prescribing in all our CCGs and in broad spectrum antibiotic prescribing in HRW are positive steps towards achieving the ultimate goal of slowing the spread of AMR.
